SMOKING POLICY

Clean Indoor Air Act

Pennsylvania ACT 27 of 2008, the CLEAN INDOOR AIR ACT (CIAA), regulates smoking in public places and workplaces across the Commonwealth. The CIAA permits Club exceptions.

Board of Directors Action

On September 9, 2008, the Board of Directors addressed smoking in Club facilities. The BOD voted to designate the Clubhouse Bar as a "SMOKING PERMITTED" area, with the remainder of the Clubhouse and all other Club facilities designated as "NO SMOKING" areas in compliance with CIAA requirements.

CSC Policy

The Clubhouse (except the Bar) shall be prominently posted as "NO SMOKING". The Clubhouse Bar shall be prominently posted as "SMOKING PERMITTED", except when the Clubhouse is open to the public through general advertisement for a Club sponsored event. The Bar shall be prominently posted as "NO SMOKING" during such an event. The Bar is equipped with a ceiling mounted air filtration unit to minimize the effects of smoke.

All other Club indoor facilities are "NO SMOKING" areas. The Skeet Building, Archery Building first floor (indoor range), and Rifle Trailer shall be prominently posted as "NO SMOKING". The Archery Building second floor (the Barn), the garage / picnic building, and the skeet and trap houses, although considered "NO SMOKING" areas, will not be posted since they are not routinely occupied.

Enclosed Club vehicles (trucks, backhoe) shall be prominently posted as "NO SMOKING".

All Club employees shall be advised of this policy.

This policy shall be prominently posted in the Clubhouse and on the Club Website.
