Junior Olympic Archery Development (JOAD) Program Operating Policy

CLAIRTON SPORTSMEN'S CLUB (the Club), along with our affiliate, CLAIRTON JOAD, sponsors a JOAD chapter.

JOAD is a program of USA Archery that teaches archery to young people, ages 8 to 20, provides great opportunities for archery achievement, and helps archers to enjoy the sport recreationally or progress to the excitement of competition.

CLAIRTON JOAD organizes and oversees JOAD events at the Club, organizes and oversees traveling tournament events associated with the JOAD program, and helps participants to procure personal archery equipment and supplies. CLAIRTON JOAD maintains \$1,000,000 general liability insurance coverage through USA Archery, with the Club named as additionally insured (see attached Certificate of Liability Insurance).

CLAIRTON JOAD collects monies from JOAD participants (or their parents) for JOAD tournament entrance fees, and also for group purchases of personal archery equipment and supplies for JOAD participants. This permits a single source for payment of CLAIRTON JOAD tournament entrance fees, and also provides for group discounts of personal archery equipment and supplies for participants. These funds are under the direct control of CLAIRTON JOAD via a CLAIRTON JOAD checking account. CLAIRTON JOAD will provide the results of the CLAIRTON JOAD checking account financial audit at the end of each JOAD season (Approximately APRIL) to the Club.

All other JOAD income and / or expenses associated with Club owned archery facilities, Club owned archery equipment, tournament events held at the Club, practice events, fund raising events, etc., are deposited into or dispersed from the Club account in accordance with Club income / expense reporting policies.
