CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) UPDATE

March 24, 2020

Gov. Tom Wolf issued an ORDER yesterday, March 23rd, for ALLEGHENY COUNTY INDIVIDUALS TO STAY AT HOME and followed up with STAY AT HOME GUIDANCE. These documents can be found @ www.governor.pa.gov/newsroom. This ORDER will remain in effect at least through April 6th.

We urge all members to comply with the Governor's ORDER and the ALLEGHENY COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT (ACHD) recommendations.

We must all do our part to help control the virus that causes COVID-19. Please do your part.

As stated in previous updates, **ALL CLUB RANGES & FACILITIES** are CLOSED except for TAKEOUT FOOD SERVICE in compliance with the ORDER and issued guidance. We will continue to provide TAKEOUT FOOD SERVICE as a service to our members, guests and the community as advertised on the Club website and in email blasts.

We understand that closure of CLUB RANGES & FACILITIES is an inconvenience to our members. It is also a significant financial burden for the Club. We are actively maintaining the security of the Club and the condition of the facilities and ranges. We are continuously sanitizing the Clubhouse to support providing TAKEOUT FOOD SERVICE. Hopefully, we will control the spread of the virus so that we can open ranges soon. Please note that you are allowed to travel to pick up takeout food.

Near term cancellations include ALL scheduled Club events through April 6th, including the April 4th 22 Rimfire Metallic Silhouette Match and the April 5th EASTER HAM SHOOT BUFFET, and the associated Clay Target, Rifle & Archery events.
