CONTINUOUS CLUB IMPROVEMENTS.....

○ **All Ranges are operating as normal.**

- Rifle held a High Power Rifle Match on August 14th, with 4 shooters in attendance. The next High Power Match will be held on August 11th at 9 am.
- A 22 LR Pistol Silhouette Match was held at Pistol Range 1 on August 29th, with 7 shooters in attendance. The next Match will be held on September 26th @ 1 pm on Pistol Range 1.
- A USPSA ACTION PISTOL MATCH was held on Sunday, August 15th, with the next Match to be held on September 19th at 9 am.
- TRAP and SKEET SUMMER LEAGUES have been completed, with 39 shooters completing the Skeet league and 31 shooters completing the Trap league. Fall Skeet and Trap Leagues are now starting. Skeet is manned for leagues & practice on Sundays at 12:30 pm. Tuesdays at 9:00 am, and Wednesdays at 5:00 pm. Beginning September 8th, Trap will be manned for leagues and practice on Sundays at 12:30 pm and Wednesdays at 5:00 pm.

CONTINUOUS CLUB IMPROVEMENTS.....

SOME ITEMS OF NOTE:

- The Club has ordered and received 50 flats of shotgun shells and are providing them to Skeet and Trap league members at cost to help continue participation in the fall leagues.
- A “Fundamentals of Handgun Safety and Marksmanship” training course has been offered for October 2nd, but has filled up rapidly.
- A US LawShield Seminar was conducted on Tuesday, August 31st. Another seminar will be offered on Tuesday, September 28th.
- Plans for construction of the new maintenance building are proceeding. An engineering firm is providing assistance to jump start the permit process and have presented preliminary plans. However, we may be on hold with this project for a while. Building quotes received last November have essentially DOUBLED, severely impacting our budgetary restraints.
- The rifle road drainage repair work that was previously approved is on hold because of business concerns of the contractor who was volunteering the labor.
- The Archery Building furnace will be replaced in August. The existing furnace has a cracked heat exchanger.
- Action Pistol Bay 6 repairs are nearing completion.
- In the near future, Range Officer (RO) & Range Safety Officer (RSO) expectations, training and communications topics will be sent to all ROs & RSOs via periodic emails. These will highlight specific safety concerns and topics that we all need to focus on and help enforce while at the Club.
- Please note that the garbage dumpsters located at the Clubhouse are for CLUB GENERATED WASTE ONLY. Do not bring your personal trash to the Club to dispose of.
- Consistent with our Long Range Club Improvement Plan, badly deteriorated trap houses 5 & 6 were recently demolished and were replaced with precast concrete houses. Great job by the trap folks!
