CSC SHOTGUN PATTERNING BOARD

With Spring Turkey season approaching on April 24th for Junior Hunters and May 1st to 31st statewide, hunters may want to pattern their shotguns.

The Club Shotgun Patterning Board is available for hunters and clay target shooters to check the shot patterns of their shotguns using various chokes and loads. The Patterning Board is located behind the Clubhouse. There are markers in the ground at 20, 40 & 60 yards. You will need to bring about 4 foot square paper or cardboard to check the patterns. Note that the patterning board cannot be used when Skeet, Trap, or 5-Stand are operating.



HUNTERS: Turkey hunters frequently pattern their shotguns for their quest of the TURKEY. Hunters routinely pattern their shotguns at 20, 40 & 60 yards.

SKEET SHOOTERS: Skeet targets are shot at approximately 21 yards. Patterning board shooting distance is 20 to 25 yards.

TRAP SHOOTERS: Trap targets are shot from the 16 yard line back to the 27 yard line. This results in shooting distances of approximately 30 to 35 yards (16 yard line) out to approximately 40 to 45 yards (27 yard line), and perhaps 45 to 55 yards when shooting doubles. Patterning board shooting distances range from 30 to 55 yards.

SPORTING CLAY SHOOTERS: Sporting clay targets are shot at various distances from approximately 15 yards out to 60 yards plus. Patterning board shooting distances are 15 to 60 plus yards.
