## FALL 2018 SKEET LEAGUE

### Tier Format

**Note:** *This format focuses on competition, and on the individual and their continued competitive development, as well as the opportunity to compete for 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> place within a tier comprised of shooters with a similar starting average score, plus advance to a higher average score tier in subsequent leagues. High gun overall within each class (12 gauge and .410 bore) and top shooters overall continue to be recognized for their shooting skills. Components of the league (tier format, prizes, banquets) are subject to modification with future leagues. Shooters suggestions are welcome.*

#### **General Overview**

The skeet league guidelines are posted in the clubhouse and on the club's website.

The skeet league is open to all club members.

Each Fall, Winter and Summer league consists of a comparable number of shooters being assigned to a tier. Each tier is composed from a range of shooter's averages from the previous league, or an average from participation 1 to 3 previous leagues, or a new league shooter's average after week three or four. For example, 40 shooters may breakdown into 5 tiers, 8 shooters per tier, with Tier 1 consisting of shooters whose average score is between 22.5 – 25, the range for Tier 2 could be 20 – 22.5, Tier 3 could be 18 – 20, etc.

Shooters can participate in either the 12 gauge class or .410 bore class, or both. For the 12 gauge class, 12 gauge shotguns or smaller gauges (i.e., 20 gauge or 28 gauge) can be used.

FEES are \$5.50 per round for adults. If both classes are shot, then the fee is \$4.50 per round. Junior fees are \$4.50 per round, and if both classes are shot, then the fee is \$3.50 per round.

Each league runs 16-17 weeks. During each week, league rounds can be shot Tuesdays from 9am – 1pm, Wednesdays from 5pm – 9pm, and Sundays from 12:30pm – 3:30pm. League rounds can also be shot during off hours. Unfinished league weeks are scored as a zero (0).

Each league culminates with an awards buffet banquet. Monetary prizes are awarded to the top 2 shooters within each Tier, with the overall High Gun receiving additional payout; the overall most improved shooter; and a selection of shooters from a modified Louis Class selection of scores. Door prizes may also be awarded.

All shooters competing in and completing all three leagues (Fall, Winter, Summer) will receive an additional award at the end of the Summer League.
