SKEET LEAGUE GUIDELINES

SKEET conducts three in-house leagues that run throughout the year. The intent is that the leagues are social events as opposed to intense competition.

The **FALL LEAGUE** runs from approximately early September through early December.

The **WINTER LEAGUE** runs from approximately early January through mid-April.

The **SUMMER LEAGUE** runs from approximately late April through mid-August.

Leagues usually run 16 or 17 weeks. Specific start, end and banquet dates are announced in advance of each league. During each week, league rounds can be shot Tuesdays from 9am to 1 pm (last squad at 12:30), Wednesdays from 5pm to 9 (last squad at 8:30) and Sundays 12:30 to 4 pm (last squad at 3:30).

Shooters can participate in either the 12 gauge or 410 bore league, or both. 20 gauge and 28 gauge can also be shot in the 12-gauge league. If there are less than 6 shooters, the 410 league will be for honors only (no prize \$) at \$4 a round.

LEAGUE GUIDELINES

- Shooters must be members.
- Fees are \$6:00 per round. Junior fees are \$5.00.
- Shooters must complete the league (shoot the designated number of rounds) to be eligible for prize money. Join at any time.
- Each league is scored separately and prize money will be paid out based on Lewis Class Rules. The prize money will be distributed evenly among the classes and within each class the top three shooters will receive 50%, 30% & 20% respectively of the money available to each class.
- Ties will be handled according to Lewis Class Purse rules.
