SKEET LEAGUE GUIDELINES

SKEET conducts three in-house leagues that run throughout the year. The intent is that the leagues are social events as opposed to intense competition.

The **FALL LEAGUE** runs from approximately early September through early December.

The **WINTER LEAGUE** runs from approximately early January through mid-April.

The **SUMMER LEAGUE** runs from approximately late April through mid-August.

Each league runs approximately 16 weeks. Specific start, end and banquet dates are announced in advance of each league. During each week, league rounds can be shot Tuesdays from 9am – 1pm, Wednesdays from 5pm – 9pm, and Sundays from 12:30pm – 4pm. League rounds can also be shot during off hours. Unfinished league weeks are scored as a zero (0).

Shooters can participate in either the 12 gauge class or .410 bore class, or both. For the 12 gauge class, 12 gauge shotguns or smaller gauges (i.e., 20 gauge or 28 gauge) can be used.

After Week 4, shooter's tier assignment and scores are posted. Shooters compete for high score within each tier, in both the 12 gauge and .410 bore classes.

Each league culminates with an awards buffet banquet. Monetary prizes are awarded to the high 12 gauge gun overall, high .410 bore gun overall, the top 2 shooters in Tier 1, and top shooter in each of the remaining tiers. Door prizes are also awarded.

LEAGUE GUIDELINES:

- Shooters must be members.
- FEES are \$5.50 per round. If both classes are shot, then the fee is \$4.50 per round. Junior fees are \$4.00 per round, and if both classes are shot, then the fee is \$3.50 per round.
- Shooters must shoot their first round by the end of Week 4 to participate.
- Shooters should shoot no more than 3 weeks ahead of or 3 weeks behind the league schedule. It's understood that individual circumstances vary. If shooters cannot meet the 3-week guideline, please discuss it with Skeet personnel.
- The number of tiers, the range of scores within each tier, and assignment to a tier is based on the number of league shooters is composed and posted after Week 4. Tier assignment is set by Skeet personnel; based on a shooter's average from the previous league, or the average of the first 4 weeks if the shooter had not participated in the previous league.
- A shooter's ranking within their tier is based on the sum of their weekly scores.
- All shooters competing in and completing all three leagues (Fall, Winter, Summer) will receive an additional award at the end of the Summer League.
- Monetary prizes, door prizes, 3 league prizes, and the banquet are determined by Skeet personnel; based on available league income (\$2.00 per league week, \$1.00 per league for Juniors).
- Shooters must complete the league or leagues to be eligible for awards.
- In the event of a tie within an award category (high 12 gauge gun overall, high .410 bore gun overall, top 2 shooters in Tier 1, top shooter in the remaining tiers), the award will be split.
- A plaque is maintained in the Clubhouse Bar with the names of High Gun Overall winners.
