Weekly Drawing Rules

The Club will conduct a weekly drawing for the benefit of Club members in full compliance with the Club Small Games of Chance (SGOC) license and associated requirements.

1. The cost of a chance is \$1.00.
2. The payout percentage will be 100%, with 100% being JACKPOT paid to the eligible winner.
3. Each drawing JACKPOT will consist either of:
 - **1)** 100% of the amount collected during the operating week when there was an eligible winner the previous week, or
 - **2)** the carryover JACKPOT amount plus 100% of the amount collected during the operating week when there was no eligible winner the previous week.
4. The drawing will be conducted at 9:00 pm on Wednesday.
5. The eligible winner need NOT be present at the time of the drawing.
6. To be eligible to collect the JACKPOT, Club members must sign (i.e., date, card number, print name, and sign) the weekly drawing book during the operating week which runs from Thursday through Wednesday, pay the \$1.00 cost of a chance, and have the drawn membership card number. Junior members must be 18 to participate. The book can be signed any time the Bar is open (currently Wednesday 5:00 pm 'till ?, and Sunday 12 noon 'till ?). If the Club member's card number is drawn and he / she is NOT signed in, the JACKPOT will be carried over to the next operating week.
7. If the Club is closed for any reason on a Wednesday, the operating week will be extended to the following Wednesday.
8. Each Club member's membership card number will be used to determine the drawn number. A four digit number is used. Three digit membership card numbers are to be preceded by a "0", two digit numbers by "00", and single digit numbers by "000". For example, membership card number 200 will be 0200 for the drawing, 20 will be 0020, and 2 will be 0002.
9. The drawn number will be determined by pulling a numbered pill from each of four pill bottles. There are currently 1,500+ Club members, with card numbers extending into the 1,900's. The first pill bottle will contain pills numbered "0" and "1", and will represent the first digit. The second bottle will contain pills numbered "0 through 9" (this may change depending on the card numbers of Club members), and will represent the second digit. The third and fourth bottles will contain pills numbered "0 through 9", and will represent the third and fourth digits, respectively. A paper listing of current members and their card numbers will be checked at the drawing. If a drawn number DOES NOT correspond to a current Club member card number (ie, that number is not currently in use), the number will be redrawn.
10. The operating week's drawn number, Club member's name, and JACKPOT amount will be posted in the Bar and on the website. If the Club member is eligible to collect the JACKPOT, it will also be posted and the Club member will be notified.
