

Dear Clairton Members:

The Golden Triangle Skeet League (GTSL) has returned and will start October 6th. Over the past several months, we have been getting an increased number of new skeet shooters, so I wanted to share another way to meet new people and shoot at different gun club facilities.

The GTSL is a winter traveling skeet league that starts in October and ends usually in March. 5-gun clubs are currently involved: Clairton, Greater Pittsburgh, Library, Millvale and Tarentum.

Match-ups are routinely done every 2 weeks on Sundays except for November and December months to accommodate for holidays and hunting seasons. Match-ups are against one club that we face twice during the season, (once at home and once away) making a total of 10 shoots.

Each match-up is 50 targets (2 rounds of skeet) and the cost is \$15 per match-up. Each match-up win/loss is determined by two things.

- 1. Scratch- The top 5 shooters from each match-up.
- 2. Handicap- The top 5 handicap shooters from each match-up.
 - a. The best scores out of 250 from each category will determine the winner for that category. We can win both, win one or lose both.

The biggest concern that shooters have is that they think they need to be good shooters to participate. This is NOT the case. Winning is only a bonus. The overall goal of GTSL is to get shooters involved, meet new people, and shoot at different clubs. You don't need to be a member of any club; however, it is encouraged that you are.
